



## Weekly One Liners 20th to 26th May 2019

#### **National Affairs**

- As per Election Commission of India, the 2019 Lok Sabha elections witnessed a voter turnout of 67.10% (interim), which is the highest ever voter turnout in the history of general elections.
- Kerala became the first state to tap into masala bond market by listing the Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board (KIIFB)'s masala bond worth of USD 312 million (Rs 2,150 crore) in London Stock Exchange (LSE)'s International Securities Market (ISM).
- The Meghalaya government has approved setting up of a commission to look into the problem faced by farmers.
- The Jamaat-ul-Mujahideen Bangladesh also called as Jamaat-ul-Mujahideen India or Jamaat-ul-Mujahideen Hindustan has been declared as a banned terrorist organization by the government of India.
- Odisha's ruling Biju Janata Dal (BJD) headed by incumbent Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik is all set to form a government for a fifth consecutive term. The new Cabinet is likely to be sworn-in on 27th May 2019.



#### **International Affairs**

- The World Bank and the Commonwealth Bank of Australia (CommBank) have teamed up to enable recording of secondary market bond trading using blockchain tech.
- The World Health Organization (WHO) declared Algeria and Argentina as malaria-free, with no recorded cases of indigenous transmission of the disease since 2013 and 2010 respectively.

#### Agreements/MoUs Signed

- Tech Mahindra announced its biggest defence order worth over Rs 300 crore with the Indian Navy.
- Asian Development Bank has signed an agreement to provide USD 750 million equivalent in Indian rupee long-term financing to electrify railway tracks in India.
- The Department of Biotechnology (DBT) under Ministry of Science and Technologyand Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), under Prime Minister of India, has signed an MoU for supporting joint collaborative research programmes in the area of Cancer.

#### **Summits and Conferences**

- External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj represented India in the meeting of Council of Foreign Ministers (CFM) of Shanghai Cooperation Organisation held in Bishkek, Kyrgyz Republic.
- The Turkmenistan-Afghanistan-Pakistan-India (TAPI) gas pipeline meeting was held in Ashgabat, Turkmenistan.
- National Security Advisor Ajit Doval has stated that technology will play a pivotal role in guarding the borders in days to come as security challenges are increasing day by day. Doval was addressing 17th Investiture Ceremony of Border Security Force, BSF in New Delhi.

#### **Banking/Economy/Business News**

- The State Bank of India (SBI) has announced a strategic partnership with the FMCG arm of The Art of Living – Sri Sri Tattva.
- State-run telco BSNL has announced that it has joined hands with internet major Google to expand its WiFi footprint across the country.
- Reliance Industries has toppled stateowned Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) to become the country's biggest company by revenue.
- Social media giant Facebook has apparently formed a new financial tech firm, Libra Networks LLC, in Geneva, Switzerland.
- Ride-hailing company Ola has launched Ola Money SBI Credit Card in partnership with SBI Card, one of India's largest credit card issuers.
- The HDFC group has overtaken the 151-year-old Tata group to emerge as India's most valuable by way of market capitalization (m-cap).



- The Reserve Bank of India has announced that it will allow large modern currency chests to increase the service charges on cash deposited by non-chest bank branches from the existing rate of Rs5 per packet of 100 pieces to a higher rate subject to a maximum of Rs8 per packet.
- Corporation Bank has launched 'Corp SME Suvidha', a product for GST-registered MSMEs. The product has been designed as part of the bank's efforts to provide the best products to the MSME sector.
- RBI stated that all non-deposit-taking non-banking financial companies (NBFCs) with an asset size of Rs 5,000 crore and above, and all deposit-taking NBFCs irrespective of their asset size, have to maintain a liquidity buffer in terms of a Liquidity Coverage Ratio (LCR).

#### **Appointments/Resignations**

- Indonesia's Joko Widodo has been re-elected as president of the country, beating rival Prabowo Subianto, a retired general.
- In Andhra Pradesh, YSR Congress Chief Jagan Mohan Reddy will be sworn in as chief minister of Andhra Pradesh on 30th of May at Vijayawada.
- The Centre has cleared four names recommended by the Supreme Court Collegium for elevation as judges of the apex court. The four appointed judges are Justice Aniruddha Bose, Justice A S Bopanna, Justice B R Gavai and Justice Surya Kant.
- Volodymyr Zelenskiy took the oath of office as the president of Ukraine and immediately announced that he is dissolving the Verkhovna Rada, the country's parliament.

#### **Defence News**

- The 26th Edition of Singapore India Maritime Bilateral Exercise (SIMBEX)-19 has commenced in the South China Sea.
- Indian Air Force successfully fired the BrahMos air version missile from its frontline Su-30 MKI fighter aircraft.
- Flight Lieutenant Bhawana Kanth became the first woman pilot of the Indian Air Force to qualify to undertake missions by day on a fighter aircraft.
- U.S. Navy ships conducted joint drills with warships from allies Japan, Australia and South Korea in their first combined exercise in the Western Pacific.
- DRDO has successfully test-fired an indigenouslydeveloped 500 kg class guided bomb from a Sukhoi combat jet at Pokhran in Rajasthan.

#### **Sci-Tech News**

- Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has successfully launched the 'RISAT-2B' Satellite from the Sriharikota's, Satish Dhawan Space Centre, SHAR. The Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV-C46) lifted-off from the First Launch Pad and injected RISAT-2B into an orbit of 556 km, about 15 minutes and 25 seconds after lift-off.
- The world's scientific and technical community, in a landmark and historic decision has unanimously adopted the resolution to redefine four of the seven base units, the kilogram (SI unit of weight), Kelvin (SI unit of temperature), mole (SI unit of amount of substance), and ampere (SI unit of current).

#### **Awards and Recognitions**

- Anil Kapoor was felicitated by Council of European Chambers of Commerce in Indiaand a European Union delegation in Mumbai.
- Indian filmmaker, Achyutanand Dwivedi's film, "Seed Mother", won the third prize in the international section of Nespresso Talents 2019 in Cannes.
- Comedian-actor Kapil Sharma has been acknowledged as the most viewed stand-up comedian in India and abroad by the World Book of Records London.
- Police Officer Jitender Kumar, an Indian peacekeeper is among the 119 military, police and civilian personnel who will be honoured with a prestigious UN medal 2019 for courage and sacrifice in the line of duty.
- An author from Oman, Jokha Alharthi has won the prestigious Man Booker International Prize for "Celestial Bodies", the story of three sisters of a desert country confronting its slaveowning past and a complex modern world.





- Former foreign secretary Shyam Saran will be conferred with Japan's second highest national award, 'Order of the Rising Sun, Gold and Silver Star'.
- Bharti AXA Life Insurance, a private life insurer, has been conferred with the FICCI Claims Excellence Award.

#### **Ranks and Reports**

- According to the RBI data, in Mar 2019, the total number of financial transactions done by people using their debit cards increased by 15% and the financial transactions done by the debit cards at POS terminals increased by 27% compared to March 2018.
- As per the report by the United Nations, India's economy is projected to grow at 7.1% in the fiscal year 2020 on the back of strong domestic consumption and investment. Indian economy expanded by 7.2% in 2018.
- India stands in a lowly 117th position out of 181 countries in the KidsRight Index, the annual global index which ranks how countries adhere to and are equipped to improve child rights. Iceland secured the top position.
- As per the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development's (OECD) Economic Outlook, India's economic growth will regain strength and approach 7.5% by 2020 buoyed by rural consumption and subdued inflation.

#### **Sports News**

- 2nd India Open International Boxing Tournament has started in Guwahati.
- 2019 Italian Open tennis tournament played on outdoor clay courts in Rome, Italy. Men's Singles Winner: Rafael Nadal (Spain), Women's Singles Winner: Karolina Pliskova (Czech Republic).

- The world body governing Badminton, BFA, has launched two new formats of the game AirBadminton and Triples with new dimensions of the court and an innovative shuttlecock called Airshuttle.
- Germany's double Olympic biathlon champion Laura Dahlmeier announced her retirement at the age of just 25 after struggling with health issues.
- Brooks Koepka (of USA) returned to the top of the world rankings after his nervejangling second straight US PGA Championship victory at Bethpage Black.
- Sethu FC turned around a first-half deficit to clinch their first ever Indian Women's League trophy after defeating Manipur Police at the Guru Nanak Stadium, in Ludhiana, Punjab.
- India bags a total of 57 medals including 12 Gold, 18 Silver and 27 Bronze at India Open International Boxing tournament in Guwahati. MC Mary Kom, Shiva Thapa, L Sarita Devi, and Naman Tanwar won gold in their respective finals. The London Olympic bronze medallist blew away the challenge of Vanlal Duati in a facile 5-0 win.

#### **Important Days**

- To raise awareness of the importance of pollinators (such as bees, butterflies, bats and hummingbirds) the UN designated 20 May as World Bee Day.
- World Metrology Day is observed every year on 20 May. Theme 2019: The International System of Units Fundamentally better.
- On 21st May, the UAE celebrated World Day for Cultural Diversity for Dialogue and Development to highlight its efforts in promoting tolerance and cultural diversity.
- May 21 is chosen as Anti-terrorism day in India to commemorate the death Anniversary of former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi died in a terrorist attack.
- The UN General Assembly proclaimed 22 May, the date of the adoption of its text, as the International Day for Biological Diversity. 2019 Theme: 'Our Biodiversity, Our Food, Our Health'.

- I M Pei, a dominant figure in American architecture for more than three decades who designed the Louvre's crystal pyramid, has passed away.
- The former Formula One driver and three-time world champion Niki Lauda has passed away at the age of 70. He hailed from Austria.
- Sammy Shore, an actor and stand-up comedian who co-founded the Comedy Store passed away.





Renowned filmmaker, film historian, researcher and educationist Vijaya Mulay passed away in New Delhi.

#### Miscellaneous News

- HDFC Capital Advisors, a wholly-owned subsidiary of HDFC Ltd, launched a new initiative called 'HDFC Affordable Real Estate and Technology Program (HeART).
- Niti Aayog has circulated a cabinet note to provide Rs 7,500 crore for the establishment of AIRAWAT, a cloud computing platform along with research institutes.
- Taiwan Expo 2019 began in Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.
- South African Saray Khumalo has reached the highest point on the planet becoming the first black African woman to scale Mount Everest.
- The 5th Smart Cities India 2019 expo, including Transport India, Solar India, Buildings India and Water India expos, was inaugurated by Durga Shanker Mishra, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoUHUA) at the Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.

After the Reserve Bank of India released a draft framework for setting up a regulatory sandbox (RS) for fintech players in the counter, the market and insurance regulators SEBI and IRDAI have also launched similar initiatives.
