NOTICE

- 1. Results of Online Preliminary Examination is being made available to the candidates.
- 2. Main Examination is expected to be conducted on 01.01.2017. Shortlisted Candidates for Main Online Examination are advised to regularly keep in touch with the authorised IBPS website www.ibps.in for details and updates.
- 3. All documents as prescribed in the advertisement and/ or call letter should be produced without any exception at the time of Main Examination
- 4. The candidate's identity will be verified with respect to his/her details on the call letter, in the Attendance List and requisite documents submitted. If identity of the candidate is in doubt the candidate may not be allowed to appear for the Main Online Examination.
 - Ration Card will <u>not be accepted</u> as valid id proof for appearing in Main Online Examination.
 - In case of candidates who have changed their name, will be allowed only if they produce original Gazette notification / their original marriage certificate / affidavit in original.
- **5.** Biometric data (Right thumb impression) will be captured at the examination venue. With regards to the same, please note the following:
 - (a) If fingers are coated (stamped ink/mehndi/coloured...etc), ensure to thoroughly wash them so that coating is completely removed before the exam day.
 - (b) If fingers are dirty or dusty, ensure to wash them and dry them before the finger print (biometric) is captured.
 - (c) Ensure fingers of both hands are dry. If fingers are moist, wipe each finger to dry them.
 - (d) If the primary finger (Right thumb) to be captured is injured/damaged, immediately notify the concerned authority in the test centre.

(Any failure to observe these points will result in non-admittance for the examination)

- 6. Candidates are advised for their own interest not to carry any of the banned items to the venue of the examination as detailed in Point I of the advertisement dated 12.08.2016.
- 7. Any unruly behaviour/ misbehaviour in the examination hall may result in cancellation of candidature/ disqualification from future examinations conducted by IBPS.
- 8. Marks obtained only in the Main Examination will be considered for Provisional allotment.
