#### **National Affairs**

The Guwahati Railway Station has become the first ever railway station in the Indian Railways to get an ISO certification from the National Green Tribunal (NGT) for "providing passenger amenities in a clean and green environment."

#### **International Affairs**

- The US designated Iran's Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) a foreign terrorist organisation.
- Google parent Alphabet has beaten Amazon to launch one of the first commercial drone delivery businesses.
- London is the first city in the world to implement a 24-hour, seven day a week Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ), inside which vehicles will have to meet tough emissions standards or face a charge.
- The UAE has announced that India will be the Guest of Honour country at the Abu Dhabi International Book Fair, ADIBF 2019, to be held at the end of April 2019.
- Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has won a fifth term in office.
- Hong Kong's equity market has overtaken Japan to be the world's third largest in value, behind only the U.S. and mainland China, according to a Bloomberg Report.

India and Sweden launched a joint programme that will work towards addressing a range of challenges around smart cities and clean technologies among others.

#### **Summits and Conferences**

The World Economic Forum in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) took place at Jordan's Dead Sea.

#### **Banking/Economy/Business News**

- The Competition Commission of India (CCI) approved engineering and construction major Larsen & Toubro's (L&T's) proposal to acquire up to 66.15% stake in Mindtree.
- NTPC has inked a term-loan agreement with Canara Bank to raise Rs 2,000 crore, which would be used to part finance its capital expenditure.
- As per the World Bank, India's GDP growth is expected to accelerate moderately to 7.5% in Fiscal Year 19-20, driven by continued investment strengthening, particularly private-improved export performance and resilient consumption.
- The RBI came out with guidelines for banks to set up new currency chests, which include a minimum area of 1,500 square feet for strong room. The new chests should have a processing a capacity of 6.6 lakh pieces of banknotes per day.
- Emirates Islamic has announced the launch of Chat Banking services for customers via WhatsApp, marking a global first in the Islamic banking sector.
- The BSE has signed a MoU with HDFC Bank with an objective to strengthen the BSE Startups platform.
- The IMF cut its economic growth forecasts for India by 20 basis points each from its January predictions to 7.3% for FY20 and 7.5% for the next fiscal.
- PAISALO Digital Limited signed the first coorigination loan agreement with SBI, the first agreement of its kind in the country that SBI has signed.
- The government has retained the interest rate for General Provident Fund (GPF), Contributory Provident Fund and other related schemes at 8% for the first quarter of the current financial year.
- TCS partnered with Google Cloud to build industryspecific cloud solutions.
- RBL Bank has partnered with credit profiler CreditVidya to improve the lender's customer experience.
- The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has approved the merger of Tata Teleservices with Bharti Airtel Ltd., subject to the condition that it furnishes a Rs 7200 crore bank guarantee.

#### **Appointments/Resignations**

- Praful Patel, president of All India Football Federation (AIFF), has become the first Indian to be elected as a member of FIFA Executive Council.
- SUN Group Chairman Vikramjit Singh Sahney elected as the new president of International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) - India.





- The government has announced that Karnam Sekar (MD and CEO of the erstwhile Dena Bank) will take over as MD and CEO of Indian Overseas Bank from July 1.
- R A Sankara Narayanan (former MD and CEO of Vijaya Bank) will move to Canara Bank as MD and CEO.
- Algeria's parliament appointed Abdelkader Bensalah as the new interim president of the country. Replaced Abdelaziz Bouteflika.
- Justice Vikram Nath, the senior most judge of Allahabad High Court, was appointed as the first Chief Justice of the newly-constituted Andhra Pradesh High Court.
- In a bureaucratic reshuffle, the Centre has appointed Gargi Kaul as Secretary, Defence Finance.
- President Jovenel Moise announced that Jean Michel Lapin will be the new prime minister of Haiti. It is French-speaking Caribbean Community (CARICOM) country.



#### **Defence News**

- India's first indigenously designed and developed Dhanush artillery gun was inducted in the Indian Army during a ceremony held at Ordnance Factory in Jabalpur, MP.
- The joint military exercise between Morocco and the US, "African Lion 2019," kicked off in southern Morocco.
- The Indian Navy and Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) inked an MoU to undertake joint research and development of advanced technologies for the Indian Navy.
- The sixth edition of the joint military training exercise between the Indian Army and the Sri Lankan Army, Exercise Mitra Shakti concluded in Sri Lanka.
- Military forces of India and Singapore got together to participate in a joint exercise 'Bold Kurukshetra– 2019' in Babina Cantonment in Jhansi.

- India's education technology startup 'Dost Education' won a \$25,000 tech prize along with two other winners from Tanzania and Egypt.
- The National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) was awarded the distinction of "Public Water Agency of the Year" by Global Water Intelligence at the Global Water Summit in London.
- Indian Oil Corporation has bagged the prestigious 'AIMA Managing India Award 2019 for outstanding PSU of the year.'
- Telugu poet K Siva Reddy has been selected for the prestigious Saraswati Samman, 2018 for his collection of poetry titled Pakkaki Ottigilite.
- Two schemes of the West Bengal government for skill development- "Utkarsh Bangla" and distribution of bicycles to students "Sabooj Sathi" have won the prestigious World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) awards of the United Nations.

- **Resources Development (HRD)** in New Delhi. Indian Institute of Technology Madras topped the rankings.
- As per the World Bank Report, India retained its position as the world's top recipient of remittances with its diaspora sending a whopping USD 79 billion back home in 2018. The Report was titled as 'World Bank's Migration and Development Brief'.
- India's asset management companies (AMCs) own assets under management (AUM) worth Rs24.46 trillion, according to data released by the Association of Mutual Funds in India (AMFI). HDFC Asset Management Co. Ltd has claimed the top spot.
- India's population grew at an average annual rate of 1.2% between 2010 and 2019 to 1.36 billion, more than double the annual growth rate of China, according to a report by the United Nations Population Fund (UNPFA).
- HDFC Bank has been identified as number 1 bank by customers in India, as per Forbes World's Best Bank survey.

- Astronomers have taken the first-ever image of a black hole, which is located in a distant galaxy known as 'Messier 87' (M87). The 'Event Horizon Telescope' captured the image from the galaxy that is 50 million lightyears away.
- The most powerful operational rocket in the world, SpaceX's Falcon Heavy, launched its first commercial mission from Florida.
- Google launched Anthos, a new open platform from Google Cloud, that lets users run applications from anywhere.

- The 2019 Malaysia Open is a badminton tournament which takes place at Axiata Arena in Malaysia. Lin Dan of China won in Men's Singles category (defeated Chen Long of China). Tai Tzuying of Chinese Taipei won in Women's singles (defeated Japan's Akane Yamaguchi).
- Hockey India named Graham Reid as the new chief coach of the India men's hockey team.
- The All India Tennis Association (AITA) has signed an MoU with Serbian Tennis Federation (STF) to train Indian junior players under world-renowned Serbian coaches.
