

**1. ENERVATE (verb)**

Meaning: cause someone to feel drained of energy or vitality; weaken

Synonyms: Exhaust, Weaken, Devitalize

Antonyms: Charge, Electrify, Refresh

**2. TANDEM (adjective)**

Meaning: having two things arranged one in front of the other.

Synonyms: Arrangement, Team, Pair

Antonyms: Single

**3. SKIRMISH (noun)**

Meaning: an episode of irregular or unpremeditated fighting, especially between small or outlying parts of armies or fleets.

Synonyms: Battle, fight, Clash

Antonyms: Peace, Calm, Harmony

**4. KAFKAESQUE**

Meaning: unrealistic

Synonyms: Impractical, unreal, false

Antonyms: realistic, real, true

**5. VANTAGE (noun)**

Meaning: a place or position affording a good view of something.

Synonyms: Convenience, Facility

Antonyms: Disfavor, Inconvenience, Hindrance

**6. PHLEGMATIC (adjective)**

Meaning: (of a person) having an unemotional and stolidly calm disposition.

Synonyms: Cold-blooded, Cool, Calm

Antonyms: Emotional, Hot-blooded, Passionate

**7. EXPATRIATE (noun)**

Meaning: a person who lives outside their native country.

Synonyms: Migrant, Emigrant, Exile

**8. REMNANTS (noun)**

Meaning: a small remaining quantity of something

Synonyms: Remains, Remainder, Residue

Antonyms: Whole, Core, Base

### **9. RECALCITRANT (adjective)**

Meaning: having an obstinately uncooperative attitude towards authority or discipline

Synonyms: Disobedient, Indocile

Antonyms: Obedient, Cooperative

### **10. INTERMINABLE (adjective)**

Meaning: endless

Everlasting, Endless, Eternal

Antonyms: Ending, Finite, Terminable

### **11. NABBED (verb)**

Meaning: catch (someone) doing something wrong.

Synonyms: Seize, Catch, Arrest

Antonyms: Release, Free, Liberate

### **12. CULLING (verb)**

Meaning: select from a large quantity; obtain from a variety of sources.

Synonyms: Elect, Choose, Select

Antonyms: Insert, Reject

### **13. SADDLE (verb)**

Meaning: give someone responsibility/ something resembling a saddle in appearance, function, or position, in particular

Synonyms: Under load, Answerability

### **14. COUP (noun)**

Meaning: a sudden, violent, and illegal seizure of power from a government

Synonyms: Takeover, Seizure of power

Antonyms: Failure, Election

### **15. METTLESOME (adjective)**

Meaning: (of a person or animal)

Synonyms: Brave, Strong, Courageous

Antonyms: Coward
